 Will and Testament and touching such worldly
 estate wherewith God hath blessed me I give
 Devise and Dispose of the same in the manner
 and form following that is to say. In witness

it is my Will and I do order that in the
 first place all my Just Debts and funeral
 Charges be paid and satisfied. Item I give
 and Bequeath unto my dearly Beloved Wife
 Elizabeth all and singular the Tract of Land where
 on I now live together with the late purchase I
 made of the Estate of the late John Lillard deceased
 as also all and every of my Slave, with all my
 Household and Kitchen furniture with the whole
 stock of every sort and all my Farming utensils
 in short I give her my said Wife all an singular
 my Real and Personal Estate during her natural
 Life with this reserve that my said Wife shall
 pay to each of my Children when they arrive of the
 age of Twenty one year or marriage so much of
 my Estate as she may deem their share, taking
 particular care that she reserves in her own
 hands at least one third of my said estate and the
 different payments or Legacy, so paid as aforesaid
 she my said wife shall Charge and keep separate
 Accounts for each Child and take Receipts with
 obligations to render back any part thereof
 that they or each of them may have drawn
 more than an equal share And at the Death of
 my said Wife a general division shall take place
