 To my daughter Polly Reed in addition to what she  
 has already received from me I hereby give one thousand  
 dollars to be paid by my executor at or before the ex-  
 piration of two years from my death, in full of her  
 portion - and my executor are authorized to raise  
 the said sum of a thousand dollars, first by the Collection  
 of debts due me, secondly by the sale of so much of  
 my personal Estate as may be necessary (negotiating  
 as apled) and lastly by the sale of real estate if  
 necessary - In this division of my Estate amongst  
 my eight Children above named (exclusive of Polly) it is  
 understood and hereby directed that my son David is  
 to give Credit and be charged with one thousand dol-  
 lars already advanced to him and to receive the
