about three Miles from Colcross the parish of
dumfries and County of Derry in the year one
Thousand seven hundred & twenty three at which
time I left Ireland And, do constitute make
and appoint Samuel Dunn of Mercer
County and James Dunn Jun^r of Fayette
County both of the above named state my Executors
and they are hereby constituted made and appointed

the sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament
and I do hereby utterly disallow disannul and
revoke all former Wills Testaments Legacies or
bequests by me made or given ratifying and
confirming this alone to be my last Will and
Testament In Witness whereof I do hereunto set my
hand and seal this day and year above wrote
