a tract of Land I have on Hammonds
Creek likewise two negroes (to wit)
Patsy an free Girl & Vallantine a ne-
gro boy when ever she shall marry or
is of age fourthly I Give & bequeath
unto Elizabeth Strong my loving wife all
the balance of my Estate both real &
personal of whatsoever nature to be at
her own disposal as long as she lives & at
her death to whomsoever she may direct and
lastly I do hereby ordain Robert Brad-
doch ^{my} Executor to & Elizabeth Strong my
loving wife to be my Executors of this my
last will & testament revoking all
wills that may have been made by
my me hitherto & as witness my

for them to be sold and the Money to be equally divided
between my children and when my youngest child
is come of a full age then my wife is to have

one Thirtieth of my Estate and that for her natural
 Love only it is my will and desire for the other two
 Thirtieths to be sold and the Money equal divided
 between my Children I appoint my wife Elizabeth
 Forman and George Florine executor in my will
 and testament of my Estate given under my
 hand and seal this 30th day of March 1811
