following manner
I promise it is my will I desire that

my just debts and funeral Expenses to first pay
 them As a provision for my beloved wife Jane
 Logan I Devise to her all my House hold &
 Kitchen furniture farming Cattle & flocks, I stock
 of ~~any kind~~ ^{any kind} & also the sum of fifty
 Dollars p^a Annum during her natural
 life to be paid by my Executors Annually it
 is my wish that my wife live with my
 Daughter Jane Bacey. Item to my son Thomas
 Logan I Devise the ^{sum} of six shillings he having
 enjoyed the sole use and profits of the Blair
 Lumber & Stock a number of years past
 and also, ^{as} breiving himself to me to be an
 Undutiful & Disobedient son Him it is
 my will that the residue of my estate
 be Equally Divided amongst my three
 Children James Jane & Anna It is also
 my desire that immediately after my
 decease that my Executors hereafter appoint-
 ed do & they are hereby required to sell
 the plantation whereon I now live con-
 taining by Estimation two hundred & forty
 one Acres being the same tract to which
 I am informed my son Thomas sets up
 a claim, upon a credit of ^{twelve} ~~twenty~~ months for
 the best price they can obtain & the

proceeds When collected to Divide as aforesaid between
 my three said Children James Jane & Anne, pro-
 vided they will Give bond and ^{such} security as my
 Ex^{rs} may approve of for the discharge of the
 annually ^{annually} aforesaid to my said wife I do hereby con-
 stitute and appoint James Bacey & Joseph Morgan
 Executors of this my last will & Testament
 should either of my Ex^{rs} refuse to act then I
 empower the other with all the power necessary
 to carry into Effect my said will hereby revoking
 and annulling all former wills by me made in
 Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and affixed my seal the 21st day in the year
 of our Lord 1818. Sent and Devised
