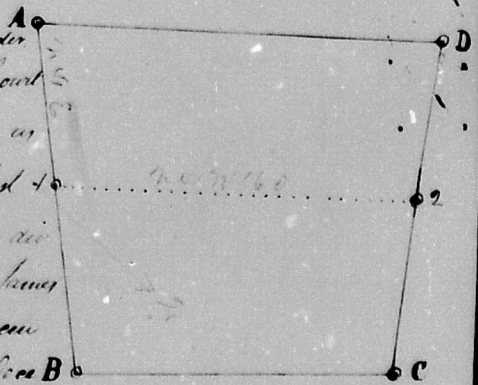

High Sarah AM. Power In deducence to an order of the Worshipful Court of Mercer County to us directed we being first sworn have this day delivered the lands & tenements Decedent between the widow of said Decedent and the heirs, agreeably to said Decedent's will. We find the tract to contain by estimation 145 acres and 22 poles consequently we divided the Tract into two equal parts of 72. 91 each. We began at the letter A in the flat a fallen dead white oak, and run thence N. 41. E 70 poles to a stone in William's line; thence N. 41 W. 160 poles to a stone at figure 2. in Jacob Biers line; and attested the plot A. 1. 2.
