State of Mind and Memory, But feeling
the dissolution of My Mortal Body ap-
proaching, do make ^{constitute} and ordain this
my last Will and Testament ~~this~~
First I recommend the disposition of my
soul and Body to the Author of my Ex-
istence: And as to my worldly possessions
I wish to dispose of them in the follow-
ing manner ~~Will~~ I give and bequeath
to my sister Fanny D. Dickinson ~~two~~
children, one by the name of Henry & the
other by the name of Delphy; also one hun-
dred dollars to her and her heirs forever
To my ^{son} I give and Bequeath one
Negro lad by the name of Bill & two hun-
dred & fifty dollars in cash, and my
Watch, to him & his heirs forever; provided
However that the Interest of the money
& the Hire of the Negro only is to be appropri-
ated to his support until he is twenty
years of age; I also desire that he ~~the~~
should be continued at school until
he is sixteen years of age, and then

to be bound to some useful trade until he
shall arrive at the age of twenty years to my
Eldest Daughter Harriet I give and Bequeath One
horse Saddle & Bridle to be worth fifty dollars
which she is to receive as soon as convenient
& And to my youngest Daughter Hannah I
give & Bequeath all my Interest in my moth-
er's Estate and the Balance of my property
Both real & personal to be equally divided be-
tween my said two daughters when the Eldest
shall arrive at the age of twenty years. And
also desire that they may receive the Surplus
profits of my Estate, for their Education and
Support after a sufficient allowance for their
general Support of the family - I wish my
property to be kept together without selling
any, except such as shall be deemed as most
useful by my Executors, and at their discretion
to be sold in the manner they may deem
most proper and at any time they may
think it necessary for the advantage
of my children. I nominate my sister
Fanny D. Dickinson, and my friend Beverly
Williams as my Executors of this my last
Will & testament. In ^{Testimony} ~~Witness~~ whereof I have

I Simon Moore of Mercer County & State
of Kentucky make this writing my last Will
and Testaments. I hereby appoint my sons
Thomas & John Moore Executors of this my
Will. I hereby direct that my estate be not
Appraised. I hereby appoint give my Land
being six hundred & fifty acres to be equal-
ly divided between my sons John Moore
by a line to begin near an
Old lime kiln on the Shawanese Run Road
near to where a school house once stood. thence
to Run as nearly northwest as may be
so as to make an equal division as to
quantity no regard being paid to im-
provements & Thomas to have the part
on which he lives with three hundred
and twenty five acres. ~~This division~~ ^{John}
the part which he lives with three
hundred & twenty five acres. This division
may take place so soon as my
said sons shall choose

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but it is not to affect the following provision
which I make for my wife. My will is that
my wife Hizrah Moore shall have during
her life the use of my dwelling and as much
land as will include the yard the spring
the Orchard and an outlot from the
house of an hundred and fifty yards wide
till it joins the tract of one hundred
acres of land which I had of Jacob Kelly
also the use during her life of this last
mentioned tract of an hundred acres
And of my Brown horse together with
half my Stock & household furniture
My will is that the Heir of my son James
Moore shall ^{have} five dollars of my personal
estate. My will is that the Heir of my
Daughter Druzy Moore who ^{was} married
to James McEllough have five dollars
of my personal estate the half then of
my Stock & household furniture after
giving to my ^{Wife} ~~the~~ ^{the} Horse and one half
of my Stock & household Furniture and
paying Samuel Moore Hirs and
Druzy McEllough Hirs their five
dollars each to be divided equally be-
