same of age then my wife to hold possession and
live on the same her lifetime or so long as she Remains
a widow and should there be a sufficiency of property
to pay my debts with out my negro woman Lizzy then my
said wife is to keep the said Negro so long as she Remains a
widow in witness whereof I have here unto set my hand
this twelfth day of September in the Year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and twenty three
