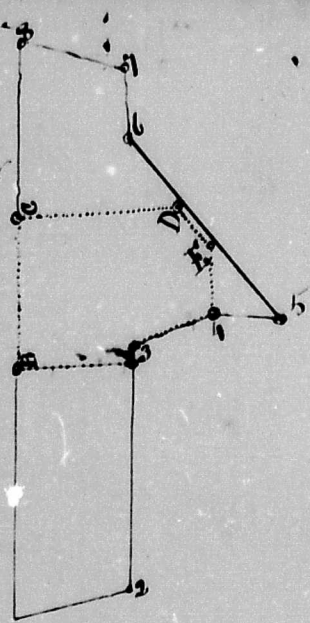

acres bounded as follows:



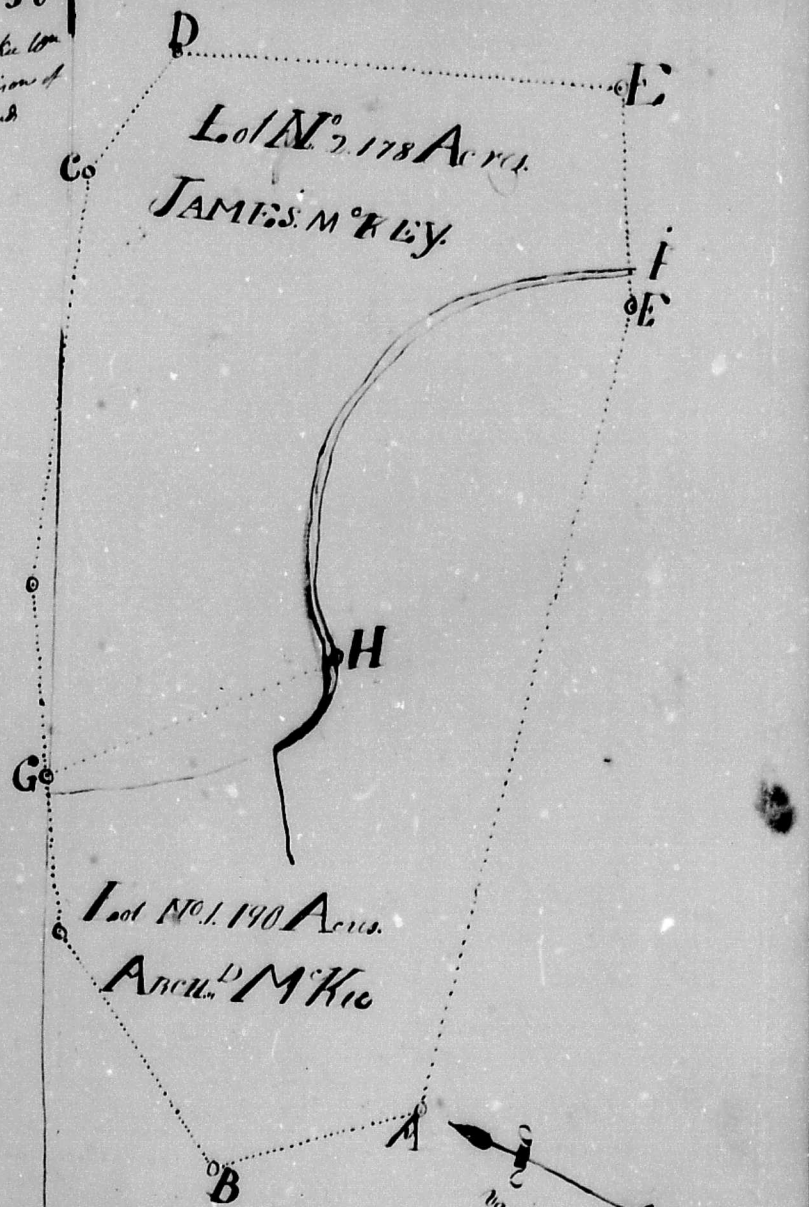
Beginning at a stake
at B, South $1/2$ West 15 poles from a large Elm tree
standing on the top of a hill and in the old road leading
from Danville to Woodburg running from thence
North 53 poles to a stake at C, thence North 88
East 53 poles to a stake at D, thence South 41 East
17 poles to a stake at E, thence South 44 East 24 poles
to a stake at figure 4, thence South 74 West 30 poles
to a stake at figure 2, thence South 3 West 8 poles
to a stake at A, thence to the Beginning which
is represented in said plat by the dotted line A.
