without an heir or heirs then it is
my will and desire that the prop-
erty be equally divided between my

I Peter Hersberger, Senr. of Mercer County
and State of Kentucky being of sound mind and
memory & also enjoying my usual good health the palsey
Exceples do make this my last will and Testament
in manner and form following to wit 1st I give
to my son Peter all that part of the tract of land
whereon I now live which lies on the South east
waraly side of the main road leading from
Danville to Lexington to geather with a Lott con-
taining about two acres lying on the opposite
side of the road near to the House whereon
he now lives in which is a sink whole
Spring I also give to my said son Peter the
Mill, Linn and orchard under the reserva-
tion mentioned in a contract now existing
in writing Between him & myself which res-
ervations secures to myself & my wife during our
natural lives one third of the profits of the ferry
& corn mill one third of the apple orchard & one
fourth of the peach orchard said contract subjects
me & my wife in the event of the Mill
dam & house or either of them being carried
off by water or Burnt to one third of the expense
that may accrue in rebuilding them or either
of them save only the wheel Mill which
having been built since the above mentioned
contract my wife and self have no further
