Item I Give and bequeath to my son John Holloway one son, Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Elgill the sum of five shillings, Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Charlotte Goodin one son, Item I Give and bequeath to my two Grand Children by my son Clayton Holloway deceased the sum of three shillings to each of them and lastly all the Remainder of my Estate whether real personal or mixed I Give and bequeath to my two Sons Samuel & James to be equally divided between them and all the before mentioned Legacies are to be Paid in Good Trade at Cash Price and delivered up to their respective Legacies at the end and termination of my Wife's Widowhood and I do hereby constitute and appoint

my loving Wife and my Trusty and beloved Friend Thomas Allin of Mercer County whole and sole Executors of this my Last Will and Testament and hereby revoking and annulling all Wills and Testaments heretofore by me made and don pronouncing declaring this only to be my Last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal This day of Anno domini
