I George W. Wells of the county of Alaca & State
of Indiana do hereby certify that I have read the
Mandate & Memorial do hereby certify & Establish this
writing as my last will & Testament in the first place
& I command my seal to be put on it in the second
place I wish as my last debt to be paid & I wish
my wife that all my real & personal estate except land for
mortgage due and to be paid in my wife's time until my
youngest child arrives at the age of nearly one year
a married for the purpose of educating & raising my
children and at that period in case my beloved wife
should again marry she is to be entitled to one third of
my real estate & personal during her life the balance of my
estate shall be divided equally among my children at the
time the youngest child comes of age or marries or as soon
as any of them marry provided my executors think it
right to give any one of my children their portion soon
or in any money due me by bond or from the sale of
such part of my personal estate as my executors may
choose to sell shall be appropriated as follows viz
first hundred dollars to build a house for my fam-
ily to live in & the remaining after paying my debts
to be put out on interest & divided as a term divided 5th my wife
is not to account for the rents of my plantation but she is

to appropriate the proceeds to the use of herself & my children as she may deem right and any money which arises from the sale of my personal estate which my executor may choose to apply to the education or support of my children shall not be accounted for on the lands of distribution hereby vesting my executor with power to see or not see any part of my personal estate being made here to any land which I have sold herebefore & hereby vest my executor with full power on any one of them to convey the same to the purchaser or their assignee & any dispute about any of said claims I hereby vest my executor with full power to compromise & settle the same as he may deem just

I hereby appoint my beloved and am the executor of the will of the late Wm. B. Withers the executor of this my last will & Testament writing my hand & seal the 23rd May 1819
