 Thomas the some of thirty pounds Virginia Currency
 and as for the Residue of all my Estate real and
 personal I give and bequeath to my two beloved
 daughters Hannah and Mary and to their heirs
 to be equally divided and nothing shall alter
 or Disturb from the Intent and meaning of this
 My last will and testament signed sealed and
 delivered in the presence of three witnesses this first
 day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand
 seven hundred and Eighty five
