of Jacob W. Light of Mercer County desire this as it
 ing to be my last Will and Testament. In the
 first place I give to my Nephew James Rain son of
 my sister Susanna: my Nephew now lives in the State
 of Virginia in the County of (Buckley) the land on which
 I now live containing one hundred acres be the same
 more or less with all the appurtenances thereunto
 belonging Vail my homestead and kitchen furniture &
 the farming Utensils on the land of every kind to
 him & his heirs forever. I give to Joseph & Thomas
 son of Joseph Thompson & George Timberlake
 son of William Timberlake to them and their heirs
 forever five hundred Acres of land in the County of
 Washington State of Kentucky, I give to my safe
 posed daughter Elizabeth Lemon to her & heirs for-
 ever She now lives in Berkeley County State of Vir-
 ginia. two hundred acres of land which I own in
 Bullitt County State of Kentucky - My Will & desire
 is that my three negroes to wit Tom, Little
 Tom & Lucy be free at my death & if they were
 free before that they have the use of the hundred
 Acres of land which I have heretofore named or given
 to my Nephew & such other things as I have named
 as given to him during the natural life of the said
 Tom & Little Tom or as long as either of them shall
 live & also all my stock of every kind which I
 now own And ^{when} ever Negro Tom and Little Tom shall
 die then my Will & desire is that my said Nephew
 James Rain shall have every thing in his own
 right which I have lent to my negroes or shall
 my Negroes choose to give James Rain as aforesaid
 the possession of the one hundred acres of land in
 that case each of the negroes have any three of my

horses to do as they please with them & they may take such horses
 as they choose. My Will & desire is that my Negro
 Big Tom & Rachel be hired from year to year & the pro-
 ceeds to be made & used as a stock money to be paid into the
 hands of Negro Tom & Rachel further to use as she chooses & shall
 Little Tom live longer than Tom & Rachel is to have the hire of
 Big Tom & Rachel as long as he lives & otherwise Tom &
 Little Tom shall live by Sam & Rachel Little Tom &
 the hire to be equally divided between Joseph &
 Thompson son of Joseph Thompson & George Timber-
 lake son of William Timberlake to them and their heirs
 forever. My Will & desire is that Tom & Little
 Tom take care of ~~my~~ Mountain Key as long as they or
 she may live. My Will & desire is that after the death
 of Tom & Little Tom all I have not said to go to
 my three Nephews James Rain Joseph & Thomas &
