will do make this my last will and Testament that is to wit
and first of all I commend my soul into the hand of God
have given it in hope of its future happiness through the merits
and touching the real and personal estate here with I have blessed
God to bless me with in the life I desire I in the following
manner and form I give to my wife and beloved wife Sarah
the plantation house I now live in with all the appurtenances
thereunto the thirds of the plantation I now live on during her
natural life if so long she continues in widowhood and the said
Martha and one of the best cows and the negro man sunk to
continue on the plantation and the negro woman Emily
but in the first place my funeral expenses and all my just
debts to be payed I give to my sons George Israel James
and Samuel the plantation I now live on to be equally divided
between them in quantity and quality George is to
begin at Dindens corner to continue down the ridge
to the middle of the lower full thence along the road
to the ^{bottom} ~~plantation~~ ^{line} Israel is to begin at Georges corner
at the middle of the lower side to go across the field

to the meadow thence a straight line up between
the two springs to a Spanish oak at the corner of the
field thence a north westerly line so as to include
the quantity that him and George is to have and
the Balance is to be divided by a straight line
James to have the lower part next to James. ^{the} upper
line Samuel to have the upper part where I now
live and a tract of land lying on the waters of
Ruff Creek a branch of Green River to be equally
divided Between the four boys George, Isaac, James
and Samuel. I give all my children that is now
a live a tract of land I am to get from the
Brackensridge to be equally divided between them
I give to my Daughter Elizabeth a negroe
Negro Miley I give to my Daughter Margery a
Negro girl named Aggey and also I give
to my Daughter Anna a negroe girl named
Polly if there should any issue come from unity I
give it to my granddaughter Sally Armstrong if not
I allow her to get thirty pounds out of the sale of
the moveable property at her Grand mothers death

my Wifes Sarah Death I allow the moveable property
