make publish and Ordain this to be my
last Will and Testament I do hereby bequeath
my Body shall be decently Buried in a
Christian like manner that all my Debts
shall be paid and that my Said debts
shall be paid out of the money I now have
on hand and debts due and owing to me
and by Sale of my Crop now on hand
and of the money debts and Crop that
will be sufficient for the payment of my
debts my desire is that so much of my person-
al Estate as may be necessary for that purpose
shall be sold by and at the direction of my
Executors hereafter named Secondly my will
and desire is that all the Slaves of my
personal estate and Slaves shall be Equally
divided amongst my four Daughters To wit
Mary H. Ryth (wife of Samuel Ryth)
Elizabeth Suttenger wife of Thomas Suttenger
Polly Bogan wife of William B. Logan
and Charity B. Bogan and that such
Equal Division shall be made by my four
Sons hereafter to be named Thirdly my son
this Will and desire is that the Trade of
Land containing Two Hundred and
Eighty Six acres on which I now reside shall
be Equally divided amongst my four
Daughters To wit Mary H. Ryth Elizabeth
Suttenger Polly Bogan and Charity B. Bogan
and that the Said Representation and I do hereby

claim and beneath the Trust of said deed
to my said four daughters then living and
expressed forthwith my further Trust &
deed is that my nephew Thompson Red
Shaw Attorney at the Surveying and final
determination of my claim to a Tract of
Land in Grundy County on his Survey
and Bound by the name of Spring
Bottom and Wide Forky supposed Con-
taining and appoint my said nephew
Thompson Red Shaw agent and Trustee for
myself and my said children for the purpo-
se of attending to and Surveying my
claim to said Land Fifthly my further
will and deed is that my nephew Benjamin
