whole of the balance of my estate of every
kind whatever be sold at Public Sale by my
Executors and the attorney arriving therefrom
after all expenses be paid to be equally divided
amongst my five children following viz
Polly Stewart David Stewart Robert Stewart
Nathan Stewart and Sam Bigham &c
My illegial boy is to be sold for cash in hand
5th Fifthly I have a bond on James Hancock for
about two hundred and fifty five dollars
and one other bond for twelve or thirteen
pounds on a man his name not now
remembered if not collected or realized

 between my five above named children
 after deducting the expenses of Collection
 It is my further Will that my exequarium
 in the possession of John McClellan free
 from charge until my executor makes a
 sale of it. It is my further Will that John
 McClellan Andrew Wood, & Rob^t Bellefleur be

 Executors to this my last Will and Testament
 and as to my daughter Polly Barker she
 has received all I was intended for her with my
 hand and seal this 8th day of July
