In the name of God Amen I Josias Harris of Mercer County & State of Kentucky being in a low state of health but but sound in mind and memory do hereby constitute & ordain this as my last will & Testament I give & bequeath to my faithful & beloved wife Elizabeth Harris during her natural life or while hood a Negro man by the name of Ned & another by the name of Isaac & a Negro woman by the name of Let & three Negro children a boy by the name of John a girl by the name of Milly & a girl by the name

of Filler & two thirds of the farming implements & two thirds of the household & kitchen furniture & a mare by the name of Charly & two thirds of all the balance of my Stock of Horses Cattle & Hogs & all the money due from John Williamson & Samuel Cull & at her death or expiration of her widowhood the above mentioned property &c. to be equally divided among her five Children viz My Mildred Loyd Mary John & Josias Harris & I further Bequeath to my beloved wife two thirds of my present crop of Corn & Cots I give & Bequeath to my sons Nathan Bezin and my Daughters Catharine & Elizabeth Harris the following viz viz Bob Lucy & her three Children Amy Charity & Moses to be equally divided among them the balance of my Crop of Corn & Cots and I give & Bequeath to my son Barton Harris one Negro Boy by the name of Bob and a Mare I bought of Thomas Fisher & I Bequeath the balance of my estate to be equally divided among my five Children viz viz Bezin Catharine & Elizabeth And I do hereby constitute & appoint my wife Elizabeth Harris & my son Nathan Harris Executors to this my last will & Testament as written by my hand & seal this 2nd day of August in Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twelve
