Knorr I give one hundred dollars over & above his equal proportion of my estate for the purpose of completing his Education To my son James Knorr I give two hundred dollars over his equal proportion of my estate for the like purpose To my son Saml. Knorr I give the sum of two hundred dollars above his equal proportion of my estate for the like purpose To my son Benjamin Knorr I give one hundred dollars above his equal proportion of my estate for the like purposes To my son David Knorr I give the sum of five hundred dollars over & above his equal proportion of my estate for the like purpose It is my will and desire that after the above legacies are paid and my debts & funeral expences are discharge that all my estate real & personal be equally divided amongst all my children I will William Knorr George L.
