Smith two fine pounds & likewise to Betty Smith
twenty pounds & unto Patsy Smith fifteen pounds & unto
Jenny Smith ten pounds and unto Sally Smith twelve
pounds and unto John Smith and his brother William
sons of John Smith the plantation containing 125
acres to be equally divided between the two and
all the rest of the property and Money & ana
to Samuel Daugherty my wages if I never return after
paying by Bills of such part thereof as my Executors think
best. I do also constitute & appoint Robert Ashley and
Colo John Smith Executors to this my last Will and a
Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set hand
& ana for a my seal this the seventh Day of July
One thousand seven hundred and eighty four
