Guardian to the said heirs, took into consideration four hundred dollars, which the said Guardian reported to us as being in his hands for the hire of the slaves of said heirs which sum he wished annexed to the

slaves to enable the commissioners to make an equal dividend to each heir.

We the undersigned having been appointed by the court of Mercer county to lay off the lower of Nancy Haines widow of George Haines deceased have proceeded to perform that duty so far as to allot to said widow her dower in the real estate of the decedent and have assigned her the land with its appurtenances included in the following bound-aries; Beginning at the north corner of the tract sold by said George Haines to John McCoy, thence
