In the first place I give & bequeath my soul to God who give it in perfect hope of a joyful resurrection through Christ and my body to be interred in a christian like manner and as to my worldly goods which it hath pleased the almighty through his goodness to possess me with I give and will as followeth (viz) I bequeath to my beloved consort Mary Perce all my real and personal Estate to be disposed of as she may think best - In Testament my whereof I have set my hand & affixed my seal this 20th of May 1819.
