being very sick and weak in Body but in
perfect mind, memory thanks be given unto God
therefore calling unto mind the mortality of my
Body and knowing that it is appointed for all
men once to die do make and ordain this my
Last Will and Testament that is to say principally
and first of all I give and recommend my soul
into the hands of Almightie God that grant and my
Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in
decent Buriall hereat at the descent, ⁱⁿ ~~the~~ ^{my} ~~buriall~~
nothing doubting but ^{at} the General Resurrection
I shall rise th same again by the slightly -
power of God and as touching such worldly
estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless
me in this life I give assign and dispose of
the same in the Following Manner viz
I give and bequeath to Precilla Thompson
My Wife all the ^{lower} and Lattle and house -
furniture and ~~not~~ to be disposed of the house
during her life and the Land to be ^{equally} shared
between John Thompson and Ellen Thompson
My sons and I do give Ellen Thompson and
my wife Precilla ~~the~~ my Executors meaning
ways before named Wills and bequeathed. Ratify
