do hereby make constitute and ordain this to be
my last will and testament hereby revoking dis
annulling & making void all Wills Testaments
or bequeaths & heretofore made by me viz
I promise I give and bequeath unto my dearly
and well beloved wife Hannah the use and benefit
of the Plantation on which I now live on situate
on the waters of Salt river as long as she thinks
proper to remain a widow and together with
the stock and household furniture now then on
and likewise the Appurtenances there unto belonging
& if in case she marries then the aforesaid plant
ation stock and house hold furniture is to be
valued and sold at Publick Vendue according to
Law and she is to have the one third of the amount
of the Sale thereof the remaining part thereof to be
equally divided between the whole of my Children then
living I Give and bequeath unto my Eldest son
Isaac my negro slave Bristol and likewise I bequeath
unto my son John my negro slave June the above mentioned
negroes to be had out until my said sons are of age the
wages or hire of said Negroes is to be appropriated and applied
to the purpose of schooling said Children and the surplus

And that is what remains of it after paying the
 Expence of their Schooling is to be put to Interest
 till my said Age & the Interest in like
 manner to be applied to their proper use & behoof
 my said sons are to be each bound to Trade when
 fifteen years old each viz - Isaac is to be bound
 to a House Joiner & John to the Stone Mason Trade
 Likewise I Bequeath unto my three Daughters
 Betsey Nancy and Sally my Negro Wench
 wholly as follows viz when my youngest
 Daughter is of Age the said Negroe Wench and
 her Children if she has any at the time are to
 be equally divided between my said Daughters
 & that at the discretion of my Executors and at
 the aforesaid time if my said Wench has no
 Children then the said Wench is to be sold and
 the amount of her Sale to be equally divided between
 my aforesaid Daughters then living Likewise
 desire that my Sherriff's & Mile Vessels may
 be sold at the discretion of my Executors and the
 amount thereof to be equally divided between all my
 Children & so hereby likewise appoints & ordains
 my trusty and well beloved friends Mr John Gills &
 Capt John Lillard of Mercer County in Kentucky to be my
 sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament
