In the name of God Amine I James McCoun of Mercer
 County and State of Kentucky The frail in Body yet in perfect
 mind and of sound memory and calling to mind that it is appointed
 for all men once to die Also that it is a duty for every man
 to set his house in order I therefore ordain this to be my last will
 and Testament In the first place I commend my soul to the
 Almighty God that gave it me and my body to the Earth to be
 buried in a christian like manner at the discretion of my friends
 hereafter named doubting not but I shall receive the same

at the Resurrection of the just and as touching such worldly good as
 has pleased God to bestow on me In this life I give and bequath In the
 following manner and form I ordain and command that all my funeral
 charges be paid and discharged after my death I give and bequath
 to my son John McCoun a bond that I have lodged with James
 Wehr in Rockbridge County and ten pounds In trade Eight years
 after my death that my son John is to pay to him I give and
 bequath to my Daughter Margaret McCoun ^{the cow} and a huffer and
 her Living on the plantation I now live on till she marries
 which to have abashed of flax seed or hemp seed sown Every year
 for her use I give and bequath to my son John McCoun the
 plantation I now possess and the stock and all the farming tools
 I give and bequath to my Daughter Joseph McCoun one huffer
 I give and bequath to my son James McCoun a horse and saddle
 to be worth Twenty pounds and one sute of flours one and another
 off If he continues to live on said plantation till he comes of age
 and if he does not live on said plantation till of age he is to have
 nothing but one Dollar I give and bequath to my Daughter Jane
 McCoun one huffer and I desire she is to be raised on said plantation
 till she comes of age If she live so long I allow and order
 that my sons Alexander and Samuel McCoun are carefully
 raised and schooled to the age of sixteen years on said plantation If they
 live so long and then to be put out to trade To the best advantage
 and to have six shillings each Jordan Edward Smith and John McCoun
 my son To be the Executors of this my last will and Testament and
 I declare this To be such Renouncing all other Wills formerly made
 by me as Witness my hand and seal this Twelfth sixth of June in the
 year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred James McCoun Seal
