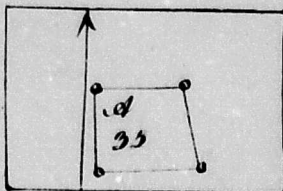

Coghill. drew Newby, who was by us allotted to her by an interest of \$ 31.12½ in the other three Negroes which her said husband & the guardian of the other heirs. agree may be paid to <sup>her</sup> in money out of the hire of the others and which will make her share equal to the rest. Viz. \$ 331.12½ the one fourth of \$ 1324.50 being the aggregate value of said four Negroes given under our hands & seals this 20<sup>th</sup> Day of January 1813
