In the name of God Amen I Josias Harris of Mercer County & State of Tenn. being in a low state of health but but sound in mind and memory do hereby constitute & ordain this as my last will & Testament I give & bequeath to my faithful & beloved wife Elizabeth Harris during her natural life or widow hood a Negro man by the name of Ned & another by the name of Isaac & a Negro woman by the name of Let & three Negro children a boy by the name of John a girl by the name of Milly & a girl by the name

of Filler & two thirds of the farming implements & two thirds of the household & kitchen furniture & a mare by the name of Charly & two thirds of all the balance of my Stock of Horses Cattle & Hogs & all the money due from John Williamson & Samuel Cull & at her death or expiration of her widow hood the above mentioned property &c. to be equally divided among her five Children viz My Mildred Loyd Mary John & Josias Harris & I further Bequeath to my beloved wife two thirds of my present crop of Corn & Cots I give & Bequeath to my sons Nathan Bezin and my Daughters Catharine & Elizabeth Harris the following viz: Bob Lucy & her three Children Amy Charity & Moses to be equally divided among them the balance of my Crop of Corn & Cots and I give & Bequeath to my son Barton Harris one Negro Boy by the name of Bob and a Mare I bought of Thomas Fisher & I Bequeath the balance of my estate to be equally divided among my five Children viz: Bezin Catharine & Elizabeth And I do hereby constitute & appoint my wife Elizabeth Harris & my son ^{my last} Nathan Harris Executors to this my last will & Testament as witness my hand & seal this 2nd day of August in Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twelve

In every thing else that I possess besides as long as she lives The Land Peter Watts now lives on which is seventy acres more or less I give to Megret Watts his wife & hers forever upon his paying to Anne Calpurn nine pounds six shillings And the same to Susanah Schooling and the same to my daughter Elisabeth Fisher or I give to Marget Watts & Negro girl name Jany and one to Anne Calpurn named Franke and one to my daughter Susanah Schooling and my son Jemiah Fisher a negro girl named Sarah and I also give to my son Adam

290 Fisher Junior a negro girl name easter and I also give to my daughter Elisabeth Fisher a negro girl named am and also all my out Land more or less to be sold and equally divided amongst my ^{son} children And I also appoint my son Jemiah Fisher and my son Adam Fisher Junior Executor of the same This being my last will and Testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 28th day of April in the year of our Lord 1804 Signed sealed & published and declared to be Adam Fishers
