 tation before mentioned I give to my son Joseph Willis
 for his care and attention in taking care of as so long
 as he may live the balance of my Estate I will
 one Negro girl I have and all the personal Estate
 not taken by my will is to be sold and an Equal Dis-
 tribution made between William Willis Fancy Willis
Elizabeth Willis Elizabeth Willis & Ellis Willis
 and Stannah & Free Children to have one sixth part
 each amongst them James John & Henry Green
 fully I desire to that he must account for out of his part and
 after the death of my wife that part of my Estate but to her
 I will one Negro man, one Negro Woman slave
 and all the personal Estate in her possession is to be
 sold and the money arising from it is to be Equally divided
 between William Willis Ellis Willis & Fancy Willis
Elizabeth Willis & Elizabeth Willis my reason
 for not mentioning my son Henry Willis and Ellis
Stannah in the Distribution amongst the rest of my
 Children is I have given them a tract of land in
 Washington County a piece that will well balance what
 the Rest of my Children will get Exp my son Joseph Willis
 I give unto my son Henry Willis one Dollar also I give Elizabeth
Stannah one Dollar & I will I nominate and appoint
my son Henry Willis & my son Joseph Willis to be Executors
 to this my last Will and Testament In Testimony
 Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
