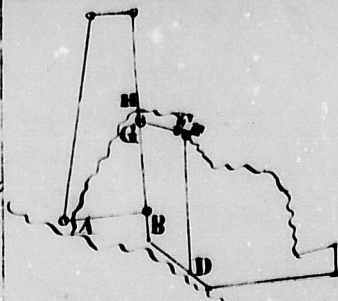


Pruevill

In obedience to an
Order of the Worshipful
Court of Mercer County
to us directed we have
allotted to Sally's Pruevill
the Meadows and Relet

of Matthew Pruevill Decedent her dower in
her said Decedent's lands containing 353
acres being one third of the tract of 168 Acres of which
he died seized & possessed. Beginning where the
line of John Goodnight crosses Chapline near
the mouth of the Dockers fork; thence North 60° West
to a Sugar tree corner to D. Goodnight; thence East
24 poles to a Hickory, a corner to the same thence
443° E. 35 poles to a Sugar & Ash trees on the
bank of Chapline; thence West 115 poles to an Elm
on the bank of Chapline 12 poles; thence
South 26 poles to a Stake a corner to Tunnill's
Dye; thence West 10 poles to the Creek; and with
the Meanders of the same up to the beginning
We also allotted to her one Melotte by the name of
Med. appraised to \$200 as her Dower in the same
Slaves belonging to said Decedent's Estate by her
paying to the Heirs of said Decedent \$22.23
Given under our hands this 27th Day of December
1813
