I Thomas Moore of the County of Mercer and State of Kentucky being to in health but sound in mind and not yet how soon my departure may be I therefore make this my last Will and Testament and do declare all others void - I therefore resign my soul to God who gave it and my body to be decently buried by my Executors whom I shall hereafter mention and as to my Estate it is my will it shall be divided in the following manner - It is my desire that my Son William Moore shall have a negro woman namede Suek and a negro boy namede dante to him and his heirs forever in the second place it is my desire that my Son Samuel Moore have a negro man named Jim & a negro girl named Nancy to him and his heirs forever - In the third place I gave and bequeath to my Son George Moore one negro Woman namede Jude and one negro boy namede dante to him and his heirs forever - In the fourth place my desire is that the children of my daughter Mary Rice
