I Give & bequeath to Martha Humphries wife of Pruben Humphries Twenty Shillings to be paid her by my Executors and unto the balance of my Estate my will is that it be divided into four Equal parts and one fourth part thereof I give to John Reed son of my brother Johnathan Reed to him & his Heirs forever: one other fourth part thereof I give to Johnathan Reed son of my said brother Johnathan ~~an Reed son of my~~ to him & his Heirs forever one other fourth part thereof I give to Sarah Mattis daughter to my said Brother Johnathan to her and her heirs forever and the remaining fourth part thereof I give to John Dungan and Samuel Dungan sons of Mary Dungan deceased who was daughter to my said brother Jonathan to them and their heirs forever I likewise nominate and appoint for Brother John Reed and my friends John Warren and Joshua Barber Executors of this my last will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
