large kettle I give to my son John and my
spinning wheel and clock and I give to my daughter
Charlotte my looking glass I give to my son John
also give to my son the table the table furniture to
be equally divided between my above named children the
chairs six in all I give three to each of my children
and I p. one of my children should die her share
her of their own body then the surviving one is to
have the property of the decedent and I do hereby
utterly disavow revoke & disannul all & every other
former testaments wills legacies and bequests by me
in any wise before named uttered and bequeathed
