 Mary Wood, of the State aforesaid and County of
 Mercer being in possession of her said property in
 and among her said property and estate to wit the said
 full living as now and established law to be my
 last will and Testament. In this first place I
 commend my soul unto Almighty God who gave it
 and my body to be buried decently by my Exe-
 cutors to be hereinafter named. Secondly it is my
 will and desire that the four thousand dollars
 which my Negro servant Venus & Child was sold for
 (some thousand dollars of which money is yet in
 the hands of the Executors of Andrew Woods dec'd)
 be divided into eight equal shares viz Fifty
 dollars to Thomas Wood fifty dollars to Elizabeth
 Adams fifty dollars to Margaret Ward fifty dollars
 to the heirs of Angus Wood dec'd fifty dollars to
 the heirs of Mary (Rayburn dec'd) fifty dollars to Arch.
 Wood fifty dollars to Joseph Wood fifty dollars to
 the heirs of James Wood dec'd Thirdly it is my will
 that the Negroes be divided in the following manner
 among my Children that is to say the Negro man
 William to the heirs of Angus Wood dec'd the
 man Thom to Arch. Wood the man Ben to
 John Wood the boy Vane to Margaret Ward the
 Girl Liza to Elizabeth Adams the boy & Girl
 Jim & Esther to Joseph Wood the boy Harry to
 Thomas Wood I also will the tract of land in Virgin-
 ia purchased of Slavery to my son John Wood to
 make him equal with my other Children in part
 of the fifty dollars they are to get Fourthly the bal-
 lance of my other property I will to be sold at
 my death and after the funeral expenses is repay-
 ed and the cost of administering & sale of the

Money arising from the sale to be equally divi-
 ded among my eight Grand sons. Namely Archi-
 bald that is Archibald Wood son of John Wood
 Arch. Wood son of Thomas Wood Arch. Adams
 Arch. Ward Arch. Wood son of James Wood
 Arch. Rayburn Arch. Wood son of John Wood
 and Arch. C. Wood Fifthly and Lastly I do
 hereby appoint my friends David Adams and
 my son Archibald Wood Executors of this my last
 will and Testament in testimony whereof I have
 unto set my hand and seal this Ninth day of
 October in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred & Eighteen
