I give and bequeath unto Elizabeth England three hundred dollars to be paid to her as hereafter directed also a good riding horse two good cows to her and her heirs forever.

I give and bequeath to Polly Humble consort of Noah M. Humble and daughter of David Mosby deceased the following slaves (to wit) Minny & her two children Paddy & Joe which said negroes or slaves are now living with her, to her the said Polly and her heirs of her body forever but should the said Polly die without leaving such heirs of her body
