wife Rebecca shall live with my sons Joseph
and Daniel year about with each of them
may please or altogether with one of them
if she chooses: I hereby give to my wife during
her life my Negro man Isaac my Negro
girl Milly together with my bed all except
the one with a two ticks that I give my
Negro girl Milly at my decease my will is that
the Negro girl my wife as above shall have
when my wife turns and be clothed and
taken care of by the one they labour for I
hereby give to my Negro man Isaac my
Negro man Coll to be allowed freely at his
my sons which my wife may live with
My will is that my son Abraham Hains
shall have my Negro girl Milly with her in-
crease after the death of my wife and that
my son Joseph & Daniel and daughter Cath-
arine you pay to Abraham Hains twenty
dollars per year as thus for Milly Ten Dollars
paid by the one my wife shall live with and
fun by each of the other legalizing party unless
the legalizing party giving Abraham possession
of Milly sooner than the decease of my wife
I hereby give to my daughter you all my stock
of every kind except one cow and the Coll
before mentioned together with all my fur-
nishing utensils house hold and kitchen fur-
niture except the bed which is my wife

In compliance with an order of the Mercer County Court to us directed we this day have viewed the lands of William Cuny Deceased on Salt river and have assigned to M^r. Drury Cuny his widow and next of said dec^d. her right of dower in said tract of land it being the tract which on the deed and last will previous to his death Beginning at the South East Corner of a stable Eastwardly of the stone dwelling house thence North seven degrees west two stakes in ellorgans line; thence from the said corner of said stable South 5¹/₂ west seven poles to a stake halfway between the second and third Apple tree in the North row Counting from the N. West Corner of the principal orchard thence Southwardly halfway between the rows to the south row of said orchard thence South 83 West to the line of the pre-emption and with the same to said ellorgan line thence with this line to the stake first above named including the dwelling house two rows of the apple trees of the principal orchard which we conceive to be our app^lable third part of the said tract as it appears down right given under our hands this 21st day of February 1815 James Daniel and J^r Palmer

I hereby direct my executors to pay all my just debts by selling the grain now on the place also this day I hereby direct after the decease of my wife that my grand daughter Eliza Haines have one feather bed and furniture thereof ballance for Catharine Gow I hereby direct that my negro man Isaac be hired out after the decease of my wife until he earns two hundred dollars for Eliza Haines and one hundred for Catharine Gow after that he is to be sold at twelve months Credit the money he sells for Abraham Haines to have one third the balance to be divided equal between Joseph Daniel Catharine Gow & Eliza Haines In Testimony whereof I have put my hand and seal this fifteenth day of February 1815
