In obedience to the Order of the County Court of Mercer the undersigned have this 14th day of June 1808 met at the house of Mr. George Linsdale the executor & Administrator of Isaac Linsdale deceased and the said George Linsdale having produced to us the papers of the said Isaac upon examination thereof and on selecting such of them as ~~being~~ appeared to have been the Estate of Nathaniel Neale died of which the said Isaac was Administrator.
