to be my last will and testament, in manner
and form following (to wit) I Give and bequeath
unto my dearly beloved wife Mary L.
Humble all the property that I may die
possessed of, both real and personal of every
kind and description to hold unto her so long
as she remains a widow and unmarried, But
in case she marries again, It is ^{then} my will that
my negro girl Patsy & my negro Boy Joe go
unto my son David, Morrison Humble, In case
I die without further Issue But should I
have further Issue then it is my will that they

estate be it more or less be disposed of agreeable to
Law, But in case my ^{son} David should die or my wife
should marry without any Issue, then it is my will
and desire, that the aforesaid Negroes (viz) Patsy &
Joe together with all the rest of my property as
aforesaid belong unto my wife Mary L. Humble her
heirs or assigns forever And lastly I hereby appoint
David Hume & son my whole and sole Executor of this
my last will and testament, hereby revoking all
former wills heretofore by me made. In testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this the 14th day of July 1815.
