worldly affairs, and thereby to be better prepa-
red to leave this world when it shall please
God to call me hence - do hereby make and
publish this my last will & Testa-
ment - In manner and form following
To-wit: First and principally I commit my
soul into the hands of Almighty God, and
my body to the earth to be decently buried,
and after the payment of my just debts and
funeral expenses: I give and bequeath as fol-
lows To-wit: I devise give and bequeath unto
my beloved niece and her heirs forever, my
negro Woman Harriet, Amy and Daniel
with their increase forever To-wit: my niece
Patsy O. Letcher and to none other, I also

273 devise grant and bequeath unto the said
 Patsy C. Letcher one House and lot of ground
 on which I now live in the Town of Harrods-
 burg to her and her heirs forever, subject to
 my disposition which she the said Patsy C.
 Letcher may make by will or otherwise of
 the whole or any part of the property herebefore
 devised &c or hereafter devised or bequeathed to
 the said Patsy C. Letcher - I do farther devise
 bequeath and give to the said Patsy C. Letcher
 and her heirs forever, all my real and personal
 estate whatever, which is to be subject to
 her own disposition by Will, Deed or other
 legal instrument of writing - it is to be fully
 understood that Patsy C. Letcher and none
 other, is the niece for whom all the foregoing
 Devises are intended and I do hereby appoint
 William Ford my Executor hereby revoking
 all other Wills or Testaments made by me -
 In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and seal this - - - 1815
