on me in my present sickness I also give unto

five pounds each I also give unto my Daughters
Fanny & Nancy Brunner forty pounds each
If either or any of my daughters above mentioned
should get married before my decease this legacy
above mentioned in such case shall cease for which
purpose this legacy was given because they will
