of Mercer and State of Kentucky do make man and wife
Philip Walker declare this to be my last will and Testament & writing all
Other and they are hereby declared null & void; all my
Debt which are but two are to be punctually paid and the
bequeathing hereafter named to be empowered by their right
Heirs without delay or defeasance —

Item. To my Beloved Wife Mary Walker I give and bequeath
that part of my Land & Plantations that both consist
of the road leading from Perryville to Danville, with
all the appurtenances, belonging thereto, so long as
she remains a Widow to use and occupy free from Disturbance
or molestation. Also the sum of Two Acres together with
the Six Acres more that I commonly worked as the Six
two Acres and give her choice of four head of Cattle
a sufficient quantity of Hay and
and Family also a sufficient quantity of Hay and
corn to feed her stock the remaining part of the year
after my decease together with the help of the household, kit
and table furniture which she may think proper to keep in her
decease, also four breeding cows with as many more
Cows as may suffice to make her & her Son the younger
part of of these men named here a Negro Boy named
Lizah one Negro Woman named Selby with her young
and Child and one Negro Girl named Chahl; all
of which legacies, to the Land and its appurtenances
she is to hold during life also she is to at will to his part
of two hundred Dollars forever which is to be raised
by expropriating to said some part of the property bequeathed
unto her —

Item. To my Beloved Children Eliza Walker now Selby
- her sister Mary Walker now Jane Barbara John Walker
- Mary Walker now Eliza Davis Samuel Walker William
Walker Philip Walker Margaret Walker Francis Wal-
- ker and Lucinda Walker. I bequeath the following legacies
To Samuel Walker I bequeath a separate legacy of
Three hundred and fifty Dollars; also all my right and
title to the House and lot in Perryville which I purchased
from William McGinnis, the house having been finished at the
expense of the said Samuel Walker. Also I bequeath
unto Margaret and Francis Walker each a separate

legacy of one hundred Dollars with one bed with all the
necessary furniture belonging thereto, also unto Eliza
- old Walker a separate legacy of one hundred and fifty
Dollars to be paid unto said Eliza the next of November
next. After the above named legacies shall have been
given unto those to whom they are bequeathed the bal-
-ance remaining of any monies arising from the
sale or sale of any part of my Estate either real or per-
-sonal is to be divided among my above named
children by giving to each and every one of them one e-
-qual moiety in as such monies; But it is fully
understood that all this sum which has already
to be paid by any of them out of my Estate is and
they are hereby directed to take in the consideration in
the above named divisions. Viz: Henry Barker who intermar-
-ried with Eliza Barker is to be charged with six
- hundred and eighty seven Dollars William Barker
who intermarried with Jane Walker is to be charged with
six hundred and eighty eight Dollars; Thomas Davis who
intermarried with Mary Walker is to be charged with five
hundred and one dollar and one penny; John Walker is to be
charged with one hundred and twenty six Dollars; William
Walker is to be charged with three hundred Dollars; all on which sums have been
charged to each or them or what they have already re-
-ceived out of my Estate and are to be taken into consid-
-eration in the above named divisions so as to make part
of that equal moiety bequeathed to them — Item. My
Executors are hereby directed to open to said my Beloved
children and to Samuel Walker who has not already been disposed
of at a convenient time and in such order as they may
think best and the money arising therefrom divided
among my Beloved Children as above directed —
I hereby wish and desire the sale of my house to be

- who is sold together with said Nancy and her two children
likewise said Eliza and her young child are not to be
- separated; the other two named as before are to be
- sold separately; Item I give to said Thomas Davis
