my three Daughters the above mentioned Land
I give unto my beloved wife for her sole use and
for her to dispose off as she may think proper also I
give and leguath unto my Daughter Anne

One Brown Mare known by the name of promise
One Cow and calf also one Feather Bed and furniture
One Eleven Gallon Kettle also a shawl and Shute
which shall be worth five pounds the said shawl & Shute
shall be purchased out of my personal Estate the
Remainder of my Estate after my just debts are paid
I will & leguath unto my beloved wife & my Daughter
Anne should be without heirs that part of the Estate
left to her she may Dispose off as she may think proper
also I give and leguath unto my Daughter Anne
Ten pounds which shall be paid out of my personal Estate
The Remainder of my personal Estate after my just
Debts are paid the Remaining part is for my beloved
wife use to dispose of as she may think proper I do hereby
Appoint and Nominate my Trusty Friends Benjamin
Beale Joseph Deckers and my beloved wife Executors
of this my Last will & Testament In witness whereof
