

By Virtue of an order from the Worshipful Court  
 of Mercer County Dated August Term 1791 to us directed  
 requiring to alot set apart and assign to Rebecca  
 Brown late Rebecca Mape her right of Dower in  
 the Lands whereof William Mape her late husband  
 did seise & in obedience thereto have attentively viewed  
 the premises (that we are informed was the only  
 Estate of the lands said William Mape did seise)  
 and having surveyed the cultivated lands and find them  
 to amount to 118 3/4 acres of which we have allotted  
 & by the power invested in us by the above mentioned  
 order we do assign to the said Rebecca Brown 46 acres  
 of Land the said cultivated premises beginning at the  
 corner of the upper field that lies on the North East  
 side of the land that passes through the said Improve-  
 ment viz, that corner that is at the North end of said  
 land by the Town Creek thence along said land 546  
 90 poles to a stake on the East side of a pond in said  
 land thence N 46 E to two blazed Hickories at the upper  
 side of said field thence with the boundary of said field  
 round to the Beginning and also including all the blank  
 ground & lots about & adjoining the Dwelling House where  
 the said Brown now lives and all House buildings Improve-  
 ments & conveniences thereunto belonging and also all the  
 Woodland in the following Boundaries viz, Beginning at  
 the two blazed Hickories above mentioned thence N 46 E along  
 a blazed line to two Hickories & Hackberry in the original  
 line thence with the same to Samuel Samuels corner  
 thence binding with said Samuel Adams Peter Lang

And John Lumsy's Line to Salt river thence up the same to  
 the Mouth of the Town Creek thence up the said Land to  
 the Boundary of the 46 acres is allotted & described above  
 mentioned thence with the Boundary thereof to the  
 Beginning Given from under our hands this 9th day  
 of February Anno Domini 1792
