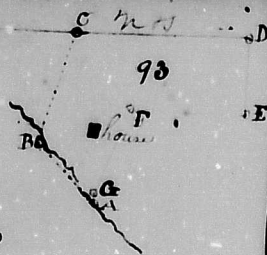


Explanation

I Fayette Roane of the County of Jefferson & State of Kentucky do make ord am and declared this instrument to be my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other Wills heretofore made by me I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth H Roane all my Estate of every description both real and personal both in

possession and Expectancy; but if my wife should die before Mr. Sarah Hunt or my Daughter Sally Anna Roane, then and in that case my Estate as aforesaid to be equally divided between Mr. Sarah Hunt and my Daughter Sally Anna Roane then by constitute and appoint my beloved wife Elizabeth H Roane my only and sole executrix without any kind of Responsibility to this my last will and Testament. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 15th day of Sept 1816
