I Someone Moore of Mercer County & State
of Kentucky make this writing my last Will
and Testament. I hereby appoint my sons
Thomas & John Moore Executors of this my
Will. I hereby direct that my estate be not
Appraised. I hereby appoint give my Land
being six hundred & fifty acres to be equal-
ly divided between my sons Thomas &
John Moore by a line to begin near an
Old lime kiln on the Shawanese Run Road
near to where a school house once stood. Thence
to Run as nearly northwest as may be
so as to make an equal division as to
quantity no regard being paid to im-
provements. & Thomas to have the part
on which he lives with three hundred
and twenty five acres. ~~This division~~ John
the part which he lives with three
hundred & twenty five acres. This division
may take place so soon as my
said sons shall choose.

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but it is not to affect the following provision
which I make for my wife. My will is that
my wife Hezekiah Moore shall have during
her life the use of my dwelling and as much
land as will include the yard the spring
the Orchard and an outlot from the
house of an hundred and fifty yards wide
till it joins the tract of one hundred
acres of land which I had of Jacob Kelly
also the use during her life of this last
mentioned tract of an hundred acres
And of my Brown horse together with
half my Stock & household furniture
My will is that the Heir of my son James
Moore shall ^{have} five dollars of my personal
estate. My will is that the Heir of my
Daughter Drusy Moore who ^{was} married
to James McCallough have five dollars
of my personal estate the half then of
my Stock & household furniture after
giving to my ^{Wife} the Heir and one half
of my Stock & household Furniture and
paying Samuel Moore Heir and
Drusy McCallough Heir their five
dollars each to be divided equally be-

166 tween my two sons Thomas & John
 Moore. My Will is that at the decease
 of my said wife the stock and furni-
 ture lent her as aforesaid shall be equal-
 ly divided between my sons Thomas &
 John I hereby secure to my wife to be dis-
 posed of as she may please all the prop-
 erty of every kind which she had of her
 own & brought to my estate at Mar-
 riage In Testimony whereof I have
 put my hand & seal this 7th Day of
 December 1813
