Anthony and in the land we have allotted Eighty four acres - Beginning at a hickory and a pine wood in an old line three rods a part of the same N 66° West 50 poles to two hickories thence N 85° W 30 poles to a stake thence N 45° W 98 poles to a white oak thence N 50° E 10 poles to two white oaks thence N 88 E 13 poles to an elm thence S 47 E 60 poles to the center of the spring thence S 85 E 60 poles to a stake thence S 74 W 75 poles to the Beginning - Given under our hands this 20th of Decr 1816
