James Brown of Clermont County Kentucky, do  
make and publish my Last <sup>will</sup> and Testament as follows  
I give and bequeath to my Sons John James Archibald  
and Daniel a tract of Land lying on both sides  
of Clarke Run to be divided between them as follows to  
my son John the part he now lives on and bounded  
South & eastward by the lands of some of the heirs  
of Willis Green dec'd on the north & westward by the  
upper line of John Green's tract that his north of  
Clarke Run also by a dividing line between his part  
and that of his brother James enclosed up the creek  
so far as to include an equal fourth part of the tract  
to my son James the part including the place he now  
lives on bounded on the north eastern side by a line of  
the land lately held by John Taddock, Lin Dec'd. on  
the north western side by land belongg to Lawson Moore  
and south westward by the division line run <sup>by his brother</sup>  
between him and his Brother. Archibald and  
it meets his said brother John's part and thence  
by a division line to be run between John & James  
to the spring; To my s<sup>r</sup> Archibald for his part the  
Land he sold to Lawson Moore to my son Daniel  
for his part the Land he sold to his Brother

18 Archibald for which no deed has been made  
to my Daughter Betsy I give what is coming to me  
in Virginia from my fathers estate to my said  
Daughter and her brothers Robert and Harry I give  
the residue of my estate real personal and mixed the  
being charged with the payment of my debts  
witness my hand & Seal this 31<sup>st</sup> day of February 1822  
My Sons James & Robert clasp and Executors  
of this my will
