 Dollars in addition to what he has already re-  
 ceived from me; I give and bequeath to my  
 daughter Martha Sanders the tract of land when  
 in the now lies containing one hundred and  
 forty seven acres more or less the same being  
 already conveyed to her by Deed from me  
 for her and her heirs forever - I give and  
 bequeath to my son Martin Dye and his  
 his heirs for ever one hundred and fifty  
 Dollars in addition to what he has already  
 received from me; I give and bequeath to  
 the heir of my daughter Rebecca Dye the  
 sum of four hundred in addition to what  
 she has already received from me I give  
 and bequeath to my daughter Mary Kates
