In the name of God I solemnly swear of the County of Allen and State of Kentucky Being of sound mind and disposing memory do make publish and Ordain this to be my last Will and Testament I do hereby declare that my Body shall be decently Buried in a Christian like manner that all my debts shall be paid and that my said debts shall be paid out of the money I now have on hand and debts due and owing to me and by the sale of my Crop now on hand and of the money debts and Crop that will be sufficient for the payment of my debts my desire is that so much of my personal Estate as may be necessary for that purpose shall be sold by and at the direction of my Executors hereafter named Secondly my will and desire is that all the Slaves of my personal estate and Slaves shall be Equally divided amongst my four Daughters To wit Mary H. Ryth (wife of Samuel Ryth) Elizabeth Suttenger wife of Thomas Suttenger Sally Bogan wife of William B. Logan and Charity B. Logan and that such Equal Division shall be made by my Executors hereafter to be named Thirdly my further Will and desire is that the Trade of Land containing Two Hundred and Eighty Six acres on which I now reside shall be Equally divided amongst my four Daughters To wit Mary H.
