make and ordain this my last will and testament  
that as touching such worldly estate wherewith  
I am possessed I give to Belemus in this life  
I give, demise, and Dispose of the same in the

I give and bequeath to my

of the plantation, two Negroes named Dick  
and Wot for life time; and all farming utensils  
and stock to carry on her farms and at her  
decease the two Negroes stock and furniture  
and a quantity with Rebecca Batoranah  
I give to my well beloved son Thomas  
and one Bond on Asa Davis of one  
and Bonds to one Dick three Negroes  
and one Bond, George and John and all my

my well beloved Daughter Ann Fletcher  
and her husband Hans, one horse and  
furniture and that to be bound and in  
of done Fletcher her Mother to be  
in majority Requires
