In the name of God, Amen. - I, Ignatius
Davis being weak in body but in perfect mind
and memory, thanks be to God for his mercy, do dis-
pose of my worldly goods, that He hath bestowed on
me in the following manner (and first to my
beloved wife Mary Davis all the household furniture
together with half the stock of cattle, with the Wood
ward, and three of her cattle, and forty dollars
that is in the hands of John Six. And secondly
to my son Luke I give the other half of the cattle
with the remainder of the horse creatures, and
the land that I live on.
